Drawing it, imagining it or chanting it three times can invoke Cho Ku Rei.

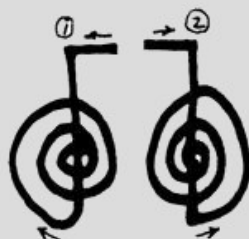
